August 11, 2026

Severe Storm Threat Eastern U.S.

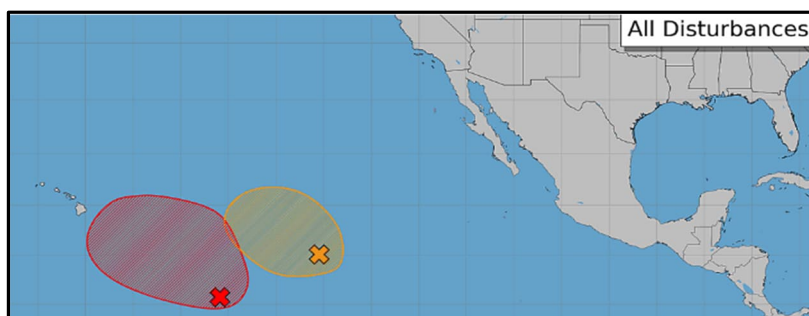
- Rounds of severe storms and flash flooding have returned to portions of the Midwest, Ohio Valley and the Northeast.
- On Tuesday, the main area of concern shifts slightly south into the Ohio Valley and Central Appalachians, where a Level 3 out of 5 severe storm risk threatens portions of the region today.
- This stormy pattern will remain over the region for much of the week, with thunderstorms tapping into high humidity to produce heavy rain and a flash flood threat as storms repeatedly track over the same areas.
- Storms will track east into moist unstable air over the Ohio Valley, allowing for intense lines to form, keeping damaging wind gusts as the primary threat.
- Although storm activity will gradually weaken overnight, the overall setup is expected to maintain a severe threat farther east into the Mid-Atlantic for Wednesday, where a Level 1 out of 5 severe storm threat is present.
- Most areas will see 2 to 3 inches of rain, but a heavier band of 3 to 5 inches will stretch from Indiana into West Virginia. Localized spots within this zone could easily top 5 inches, the FOX Forecast Center said.



Tropical Activity – Eastern & Central Pacific

Disturbance 1

- Conditions are forecast to be conducive for further development, and a tropical depression or storm is expected to form during the next couple of days.
- The system is moving generally northwestward across the Central Pacific.
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Med (near 60%); 7-day: High (90%)



Disturbance 2

- Located well to the WSW of the southern tip of Baja California Peninsula.
- A tropical depression could form during the next few days while the system moves slowly northwestward across the western portion of the East Pacific.
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Med (near 40%); 7-day: Med (60%)

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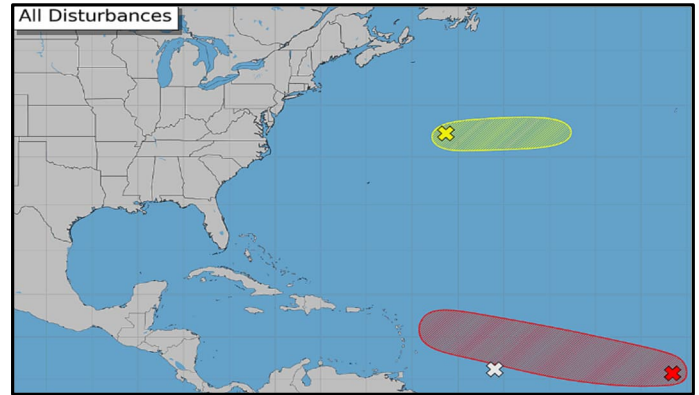
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Tropical Activity – Atlantic

Disturbance 1

- Located 500 miles southwest of the Cabo Verde Islands.
- Environmental conditions are forecast to be more conducive for development during the next couple of days, and a tropical depression will likely form during the latter half of this week.
- Moving westward to WNW across the central tropical Atlantic.
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (near 30%); 7-day: High (70%)



Disturbance 2

- Located 600 miles east of the Windward Islands.
- This system is expected to encounter a large area of environmentally dry air as it approaches the Windward Islands and development is not expected.
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (near 0%); 7-day: Low (0%)

Disturbance 3

- Located several hundred miles northeast of Bermuda.
- Some development of this system is possible during the day or so while it moves eastward at around 20 mph across the central subtropical Atlantic.
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (near 10%); 7-day: Low (10%)
