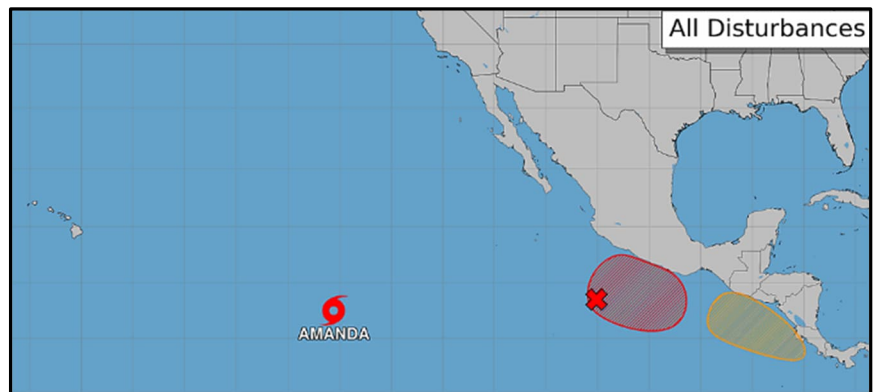
Severe Storm Threat Northern U.S.

- Millions are in the path of severe thunderstorms beginning Thursday afternoon across parts of the Northern Plains and Central U.S. as the region faces a third consecutive day of severe weather.
- On Thursday, another storm system will move eastward out of southern Canada and into the Northwest.
- A Level 2 out of 5 risk of severe thunderstorms covers parts of southeastern Montana, northeastern Wyoming, much of South Dakota, as well as northern Nebraska and eastern Minnesota beginning Thursday.
- Large hail and damaging wind gusts are expected to be the primary hazards.
- A broad Level 1 threat covers much of the Heartland, including Nebraska, as well as parts of Kansas and Oklahoma.
- A Level 2 out of 4 flash flood threat is centered on central Iowa, southeastern Nebraska and northeastern Kansas, as storms tap into widespread Gulf moisture.



Tropical Activity - Pacific Tropical Storm Amanda

- The first named storm of the 2026 hurricane season – Tropical Storm Amanda – formed in the eastern Pacific Ocean on Wednesday, June 3, according to the National Hurricane Center.
- In an early morning June 4 advisory Amanda was located about 1,500 miles west-southwest of the southern tip of the Baja California Peninsula with maximum sustained winds near 40 mph.
- Moving toward the northwest around 8 mph with a gradual turn toward the west-northwest and west expected during the next couple of days, with a turn toward the southwest at a slower forward speed expected this weekend.
- Amanda is expected to strengthen some throughout the day on Thursday, June 4, however weakening is expected to begin by Friday night or Saturday, the NHC said.
- The storm does not currently pose any threat to land.

Disturbance #1

- Located well offshore of southwestern Mexico.
- Environmental conditions appear conducive for development of this system, and a tropical depression is likely to form during the next several days.
- Moving slowly northward or north – northeastward near the coast of southern Mexico.
- Formation chance through 48 hours – Low (10%)
- Formation chance through 7 days – High (70%)

Disturbance #2

- An area of low pressure is forecast to form offshore offshore Central America and southern Mexico during the next couple of days.
- Environmental conditions appear conducive for gradual development of this system and a tropical depression could form late this weekend or early next week.
- Formation chance through 48 hours – Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 7 days – Med (50%)
