

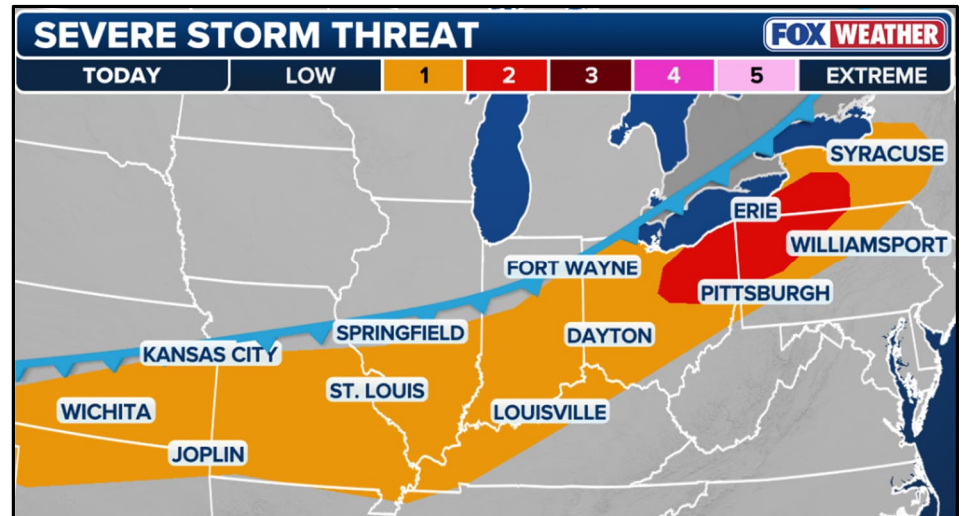

September 9, 2026

Severe Storm Threat The Central Plains

- Severe storms are forecast to develop Wednesday across a 1,000-mile corridor from the Central Plains through the Great Lakes to western New York.
- The massive, slow-moving cold front driving these storms could also bring heavy rain and trigger flash flooding across parts of the Midwest and Ohio Valley, which have been slammed by repeated rounds of flooding over the last month.
- Showers were ongoing across parts of the Central Plains and Midwest early Wednesday, triggering a Flash Flood Warning in Omaha, Nebraska, and southwestern Iowa.
- More intense severe weather is expected to develop beginning Wednesday afternoon along the length of the cold front.
- The strongest storms are expected to form over the eastern Great Lakes. NOAA's Storm Prediction Center has issued a Level 2 out of 5 risk of severe thunderstorms across parts of northeastern Ohio, northwestern Pennsylvania and western New York, areas that were impacted by last week's severe weather.
- Wind gusts over 60 mph are expected to be the main threat, with the possibility of a tornado or two.
- Farther south, flash flooding is most likely across parts of southwestern Illinois, through southern Missouri, and into eastern Kansas. A Level 2 out of 4 flash flood risk covers this area.
- By Thursday, storms will shift slightly south as the front brings wet weather to the Mid-Atlantic, central Appalachians and Ohio Valley.
- Cities across the region should also be aware of the potential for flooding as deep tropical moisture is pulled north from the Gulf of Mexico.
- The combination of deep tropical moisture and severe weather could bring heavy downpours to the Central Appalachians.
- A Level 2 flood risk has been issued for parts of Ohio, Pennsylvania and West Virginia.



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Tropical Activity – Eastern & Central Pacific

Tropical Storm Lowell

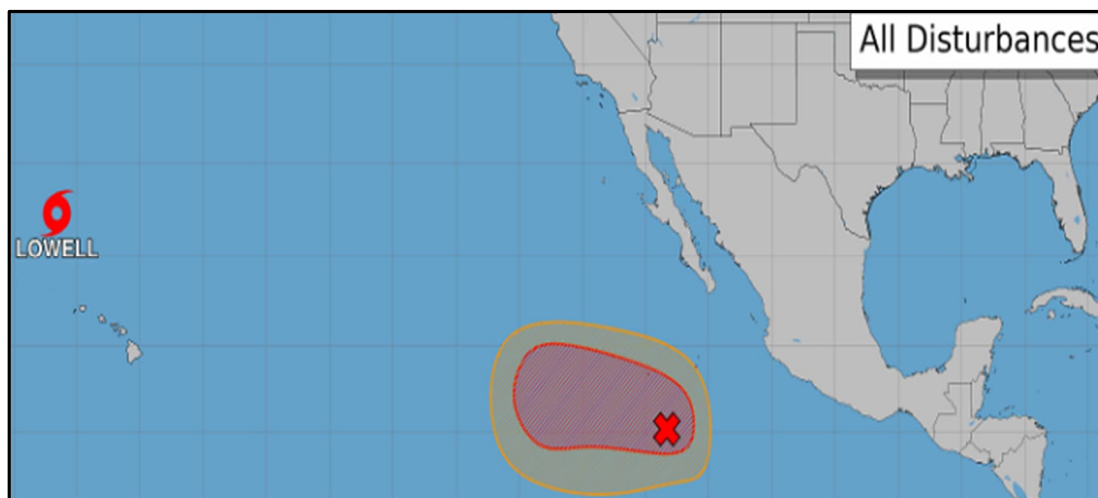
- Located 390 miles NNW of Lihue, Hawaii moving N at 14 mph.
- Maximum sustained winds of 65 mph.
- A slow turn toward the northwest then west is forecast Wednesday into Thursday. Then, a slower forward speed is expected later on Thursday and Friday.
- Tropical-storm-force winds extend outward up to 255 miles from the center.
- Tropical Storm Lowell passed west of the Hawaiian Islands on Sept 8, with wind gusts of 90mph and 12-17 inches of rainfall.
- Local energy providers are conducting assessments and power restoration operations within Kauai and Oahu counties.
- Tropical Storm Warnings and Flood Watches remain in effect.
- There are currently 5 shelters open with 48 occupants.

Disturbance 1

- Located several hundred miles SSW of the southern tip of the Baja California Peninsula.
- Further development is expected, and a tropical depression is likely to form during the next day or two.
- The system is moving WNW at 10 to 15 mph.
- Formation chance through 48 hours: High (80%); 7 days: High (90%)

Disturbance 2

- Located several hundred miles south of the southern tip off Baja California Peninsula.
- A tropical depression could form early next week while moving WNW.
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%); 7 days: Med (40%)
