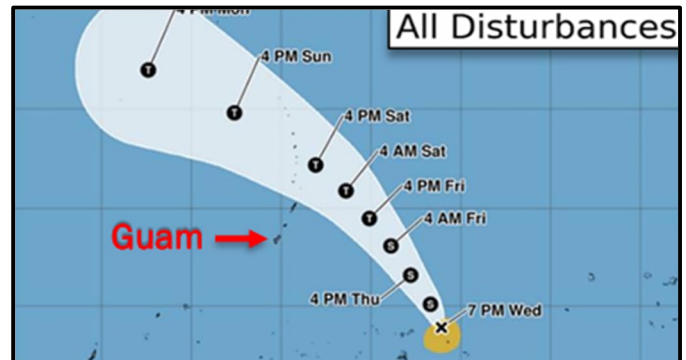

Tropical Activity – Western Pacific

Tropical Storm Saudel

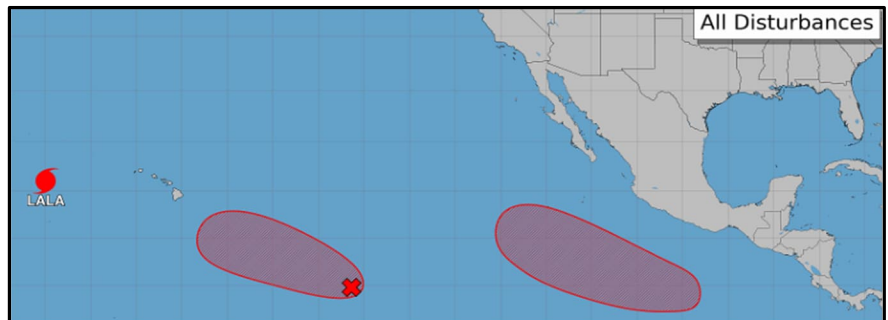
- Located 170 miles ESE of Guam moving north at 5 mph.
- Maximum sustained surface winds of 40 mph.
- Saudel is expected to intensify to near CAT-3 strength Friday into Saturday as it moves near or north of CNMI.



Tropical Activity – Eastern & Central Pacific

Hurricane Lala – CAT 4

- Located 300 miles S of Maro Reef moving NW at 9 mph.
- Maximum sustained winds of 125 mph.
- Hurricane force winds extend outward up to 30 miles from the center.
- Tropical storm force winds extend outward up to 115 miles.
- Some gradual weakening is anticipated during the next few days, but Lala is expected to remain a hurricane and not affect U.S. interests.



Disturbance 1

- Located well to the ESE of the Hawaiian Islands.
- A tropical depression is likely to form during the next couple of days.
- Moving westward to WNW at 10 to 15 mph.
- Formation chance – 48-hour: High (70%); 7-day: High (80%)

Disturbance 2

- An area of low pressure is forecast to form several hundred miles SWS of the coast of southern Mexico around the end of the week.
- A tropical depression is expected to form this weekend.
- Moving WNW remaining well offshore of Mexico.
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (near 0%); 7-day: High (80%)

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Joint Preliminary Damage Assessments

Washington

- The Spokane Complex was a group of three fast-moving wildfires that began on August 1, 2026, in and around Spokane County in eastern Washington.
- The complex consisted of the Old Trails, Autumn Lane, and Fairview fires.
- The Spokane Complex became the nation's highest firefighting priority during the early stages of the incident. More than 1,000 firefighters were deployed, with additional resources coming from other states, including California.
- Extreme heat, drought, very low humidity and strong winds contributed to rapid fire growth and allowed the fires to move from wooded and brush areas into residential neighborhoods.
- More than 8,000 acres burned during the initial days of the incident.
- Approximately 700 buildings were destroyed by August 3, increasing to roughly 850 buildings by August 5. Most of the losses were residential.
- Damage assessment teams were still conducting detailed assessments; officials initially estimated that hundreds of additional structures could have been damaged or destroyed.
- Approximately 64,000–67,000 people were evacuated at the height of the incident.
