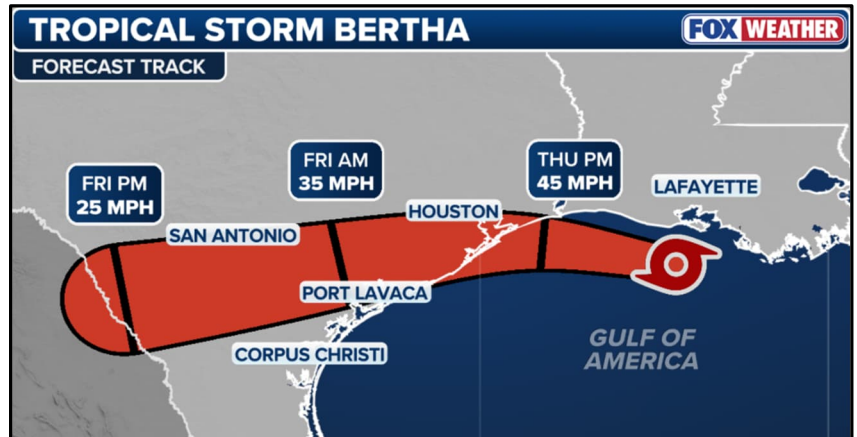
WSP USA FIELD SERVICES DISASTER AWARENESS REPORT

July 23, 2026

Tropical Activity – Atlantic

Tropical Storm Bertha

- Tropical Storm Bertha is back in the northern Gulf and racing toward Texas, where it is expected to make a second landfall later Thursday after striking southeast Louisiana on Wednesday afternoon.
- Bertha was about 70 miles south-east of Lake Charles, Louisiana, with maximum sustained winds of 45 mph, and is moving west-northwest at 13 mph.
- The storm remains lopsided, meaning that most of its rain and storms are pushed to one side. This structure will prevent significant strengthening, according to the FOX Forecast Center.
- Bertha is tracking generally toward Galveston, Texas and places south.
- Tropical Storm Bertha made an initial landfall in St. Bernard Parish, Louisiana around 2:00 p.m. local time on Wednesday.
- Tropical Storm Warnings are in effect along the northern Gulf Coast from Terrebonne-Lafourche parish line in Louisiana to Sargent, Texas.
- The National Hurricane Center said storm surge combined with high tide could bring water levels between 1 and 3 feet above normally dry ground along the coast from Mississippi to Port Bolivar, Texas.



Tropical Activity – Pacific

Hurricane Fausto

- Located 980 miles WSW of southern tip of Baja.
- Moving WNW at 12MPH.
- A continued west-northwestward to westward motion, along with an increase in forward speed, is expected over the next several days.

Disturbance 1

- Located a several hundred miles off the coast of southern Mexico.
- Conditions appear conducive for gradual development of this system, and a tropical depression is likely to form late this week or over the weekend.
- Moving west – northwestward at 10 to 15 MPH.
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Med (60%); 7-day: High (90%)

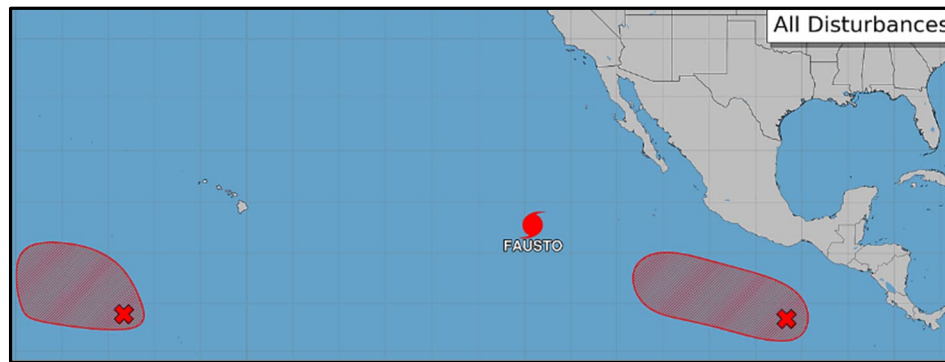
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Disturbance 2

- Located well southwest of the Hawaiian Islands.
- A tropical depression could form late this weekend or early next week.
- Moving westward to west northwestward.
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (near 20%); 7-day: High (70%)
