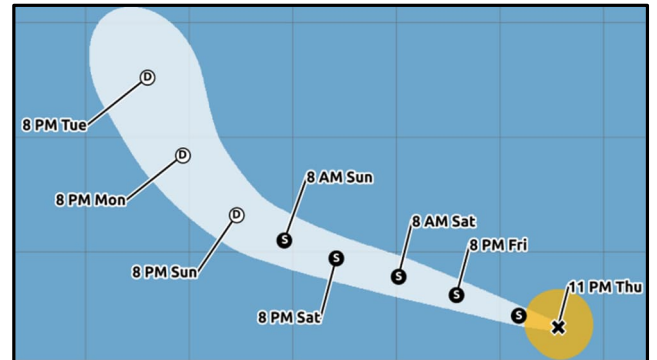
Flash Flood Threat Florida

- Millions of people across Florida face days of thunderstorms and heavy downpours through the weekend.
- A slow-moving cold weather front is expected to trigger daily afternoon thunderstorms as it sags south through Florida.
- The likelihood of severe storms on Friday is likely to be diminished after storms moved through the Panhandle on Thursday, delaying hundreds of flights across Miami, Orlando and Fort Lauderdale.
- Rounds of showers and thunderstorms are still expected Friday afternoon and evening and should persist into the weekend.
- The FOX Forecast Center said because the storms will move slowly and could repeatedly track over the same areas, some locations may quickly pick up 1 to 2 inches of rain in a short period, leading to flash flooding.
- Cities at risk for downpours and flooding include Tallahassee, Orlando and Jacksonville.



Tropical Activity – Pacific Hurricane Genevieve (CAT 1)

- Located 1110 miles W of the southern tip of Baja California with maximum sustained winds of 65 mph.
- Moving WNW at 14 mph.
- Gradual weakening is forecast during the next few days, and Genevieve is expected to become a remnant low late this weekend.
