May 21, 2026

Flash Flood Threat Southern U.S.

- More than 33 million Americans are in the bull's-eye of a mounting flash flood threat across parts of Texas and the South that is expected to increase through Memorial Day weekend.
- This is part of a stagnant weather pattern where this moisture will interact with and enhance a series of slow-moving storms which will form along a stalled front through the weekend.
- The widespread flood threat covers North and East Texas, as well as Oklahoma, Arkansas, Kansas and Missouri on Thursday.
- NOAA's Weather Prediction Center (WPC) has issued a Level 2 out of 4 risk of flash flooding covering the Dallas, Tulsa, Oklahoma and Fort Smith, Arkansas, metro areas.
- A Level 2 threat also covers parts of the Texas and Louisiana Gulf Coast, including Houston.
- Louisiana, Arkansas and Mississippi should be on alert for flash flooding, with a Level 1 out of 4 flash flood risk for most of the week.
- The FOX Forecast Center warned that in these zones, rainfall rates will be high, with 1 to 3 inches falling in a short time.
- Through Memorial Day, upwards of 5 to 8 inches of rain could fall across pockets of East Texas, including Houston, and Louisiana.
