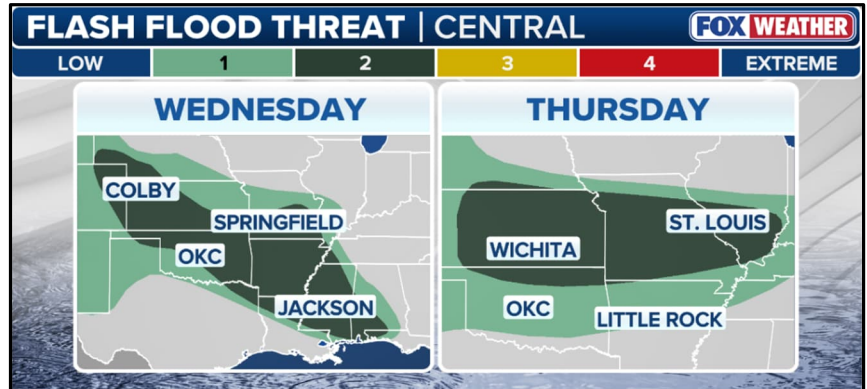

June 24, 2026

Flash Flood Threat

Central U.S.

- On Wednesday, the risk for flash flooding will expand from the Central Plains down into the Gulf Coast of Mississippi and Alabama.
- Northwesterly flow is expected to remain north of the high pressure centered over western Texas, allowing for the active pattern from the Front Range through the Mid-South to remain.
- Organized storms will begin to shift further southeast into the central Gulf Coast and Florida Panhandle through the afternoon.
- Combined with already saturated soils, a Level 2 out of 4 flash flood risk extends from Nebraska to far western Florida.
- The threat for flash flooding will persist into the day on Thursday across Kansas and Missouri, where another Level 2 flash flood risk has been issued.
- By Friday, widespread rainfall totals of 1 to 2 inches are expected from western Kansas through Missouri and Illinois, with heavier amounts of 2 to 3 inches likely in eastern Kansas and central portions of the region.



Tropical Activity – Pacific

Disturbance 1

- Located several hundred miles SSW off the southern tip of the Baja California Peninsula moving at 15-20 mph.
- A tropical depression could still form today while conditions remain marginally conducive.
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Medium (50%)
- Formation chance through 7 days: Medium (50%)



Disturbance 2

- Forecasted for gradual development and a tropical depression could form by the early to middle part of next week.
- Moving westward to west – northwestward at 10 to 15 MPH.
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (0%)
- Formation chance through 7 days: Medium (60%)
