## Flash Flood Threat Gulf Coast

- A final round of severe storms will drench parts of the Gulf and South-east Coasts Monday, bringing a renewed flash flood threat.
- Parts of Louisiana, Mississippi, Alabama and Georgia have already picked up 3 to 6 inches of rain, setting the stage for additional flash flooding.
- These storms will develop later Monday afternoon and bring the greatest flood threat along the I-10 corridor from New Orleans to Jacksonville, Florida.
- Damaging wind gusts and hail will be the primary hazards with any severe thunderstorms that form.
- NOAA's Weather Prediction Center (WPC) has issued threat for flash flooding, encompassing most of southern Louisiana through the Mobile area through Tuesday morning.
- By Tuesday, this weather system is expected to shift into Florida.
