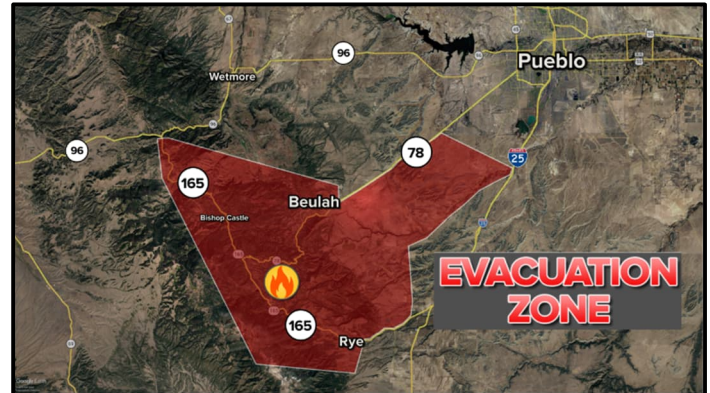

Wildfire Activity

Colorado

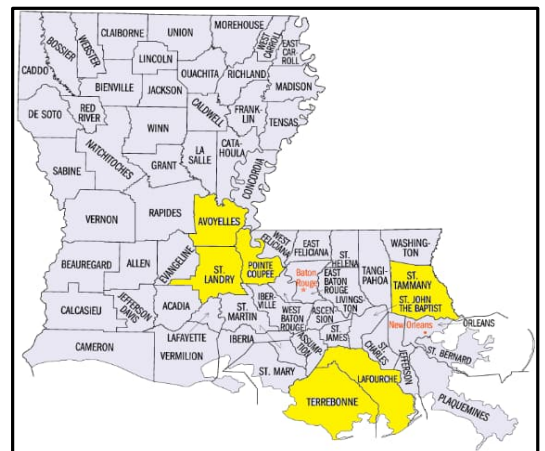
- The Aspen Acres Fire, which broke out in Colorado, has already scorched over 23,000 acres, and that number is expected to grow with wind gusts reaching 100 mph in the area.
- The Pueblo County Sheriff's Office said there is no air support at this time due to the high winds affecting the area.
- Mandatory evacuations are in effect for multiple towns in the area, including Beulah, Rye and San Isabel.
- The sheriff's office said an "unspecified number of structures" have been affected by the fire, and it's unknown if there are any injuries at this time.
- Officials are urging everyone to stay indoors due to poor air quality caused by smoke, unless you are in an evacuation zone.
- No cause or origin of the fire has been identified at this time.



Disaster Declaration Request

Louisiana

- Gov. Jeff Landry is asking President Donald Trump to issue a major disaster declaration for Louisiana after Tropical Storm Arthur brought historic rainfall, flooding, and tornadoes to parts of the state.
- In a letter dated June 27, Landry requested Individual Assistance for six parishes: Avoyelles, Lafourche, Pointe Coupee, St. Landry, St. Tammany, and Terrebonne.
- Landry said Tropical Storm Arthur brought significant rainfall to Louisiana on June 17 and June 18, displacing hundreds of survivors and threatening lives and property.
- According to the request, Avoyelles Parish experienced what has been described as a "thousand-year event" when about 29 inches of rain fell in a 12-hour span.
- The governor's office said the National Weather Service confirmed 14 tornadoes touched down in Louisiana as a result of the storm.
- Several other parishes also saw extreme rainfall, while St. Tammany and Terrebonne had confirmed tornadoes. Officials said flooding caused local rivers and bodies of water to rise quickly, forcing many households to evacuate.
- The governor asked for an expedited declaration, saying the storm's impacts are beyond the capabilities of state and local governments.

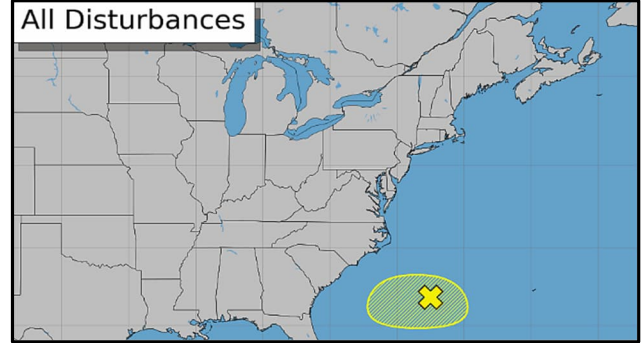

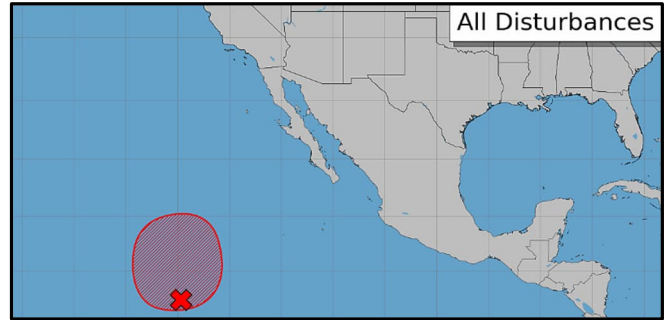
Tropical Activity – Atlantic Disturbance 1

- Located offshore the Southeastern U.S. coast.
- Environmental conditions are becoming less conducive for significant development as it drifts south.
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (10%)
- Formation chance through 7 days: Low (10%)



Tropical Activity – Pacific Disturbance 1

- Located well SW of the southern tip of the Baja California Peninsula.
- Gradual development is expected during the next couple of days, and a tropical depression is likely to form tonight or on Wednesday.
- Formation chance through 48 hours: High (80%)
- Formation chance through 7 days: High (80%)
