

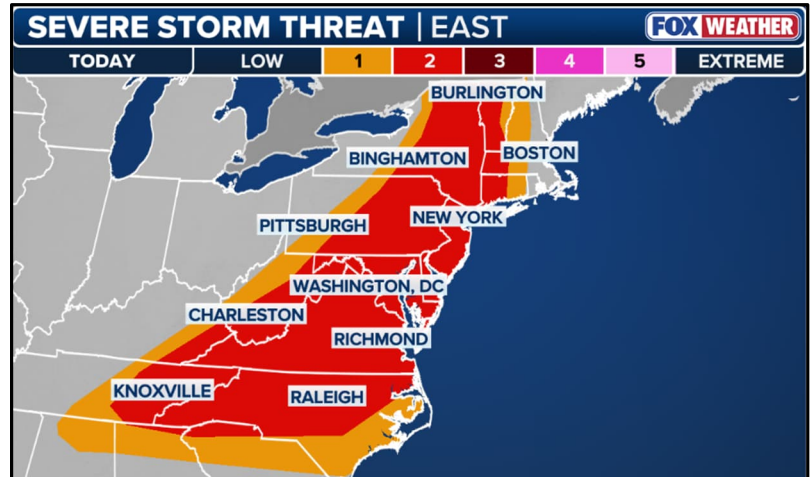

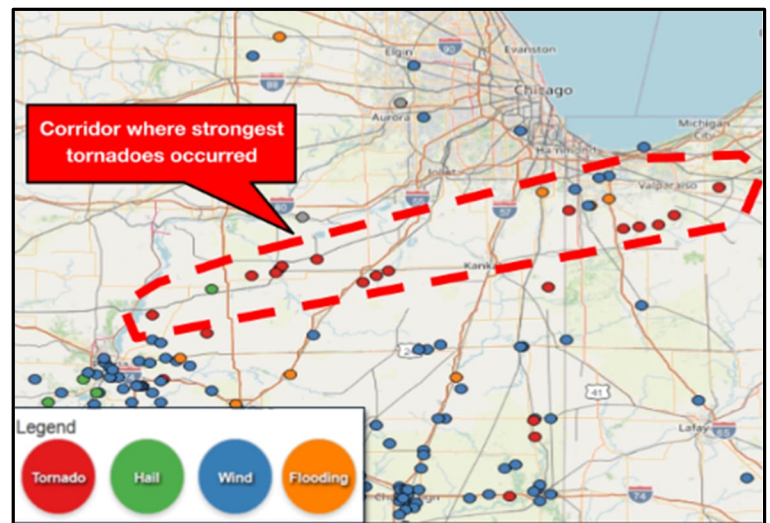
Severe Storm Threat Eastern U.S.

- Strong thunderstorms are expected to redevelop Friday afternoon across the Northeast and Mid-Atlantic, threatening more than 70 million people from Kentucky to Vermont.
- The severe weather is being fueled by near-record heat, with temperatures forecast to reach the mid-90s from the Carolinas to New York City.
- NOAA's Storm Prediction Center (SPC) issued a broad Level 2 out of 5 risk of severe thunderstorms for the region including, Philadelphia, Washington DC, Baltimore and New York City.
- Damaging wind gusts, potentially over 60 mph, and hail will be the primary hazards.
- Another round of severe storms is forecast to develop over the Mid-Atlantic Sunday, with the greatest threat centered over Philadelphia and Washington, D.C.



Severe Weather Activity

- Numerous tornadoes and powerful straight-line winds ripped across communities in northern Illinois and northwestern Indiana on Thursday.
- Destroying homes and toppling trees and power lines amid a severe weather outbreak across the Midwest.
- The National Weather Service (NWS) reported radar-confirmed tornadoes striking towns across both states, including Streator, St. John, Hobart, Merrillville, Hebron, Boone/Kouts and the Wabash/Largo area.
- Nearly 500,000 customers across Illinois, Indiana, Wisconsin and Michigan were still without power early Friday.
- Law enforcement in Streator, Illinois, said heavy damage has been reported in the city.
- City officials said crews are working in areas affected by the tornado, and they're asking residents to avoid traveling to impacted neighborhoods unless they live in the area or have a legitimate need to be there.

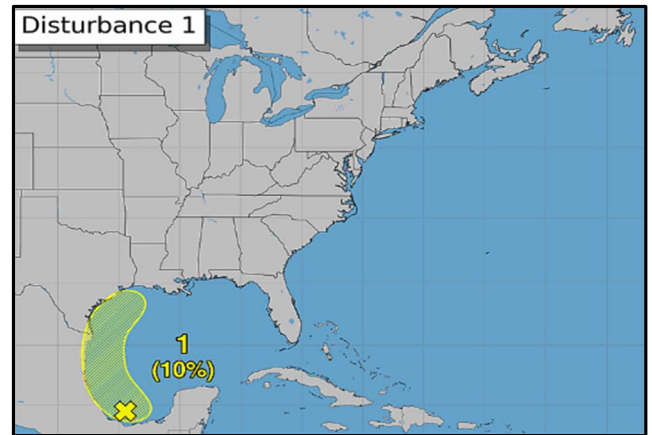

- Extensive damage has also been reported across the town of Merrillville, Indiana, due to Thursday night's storm.
- The town said there are road closures throughout Merrillville due to downed trees and power lines.
- Officials have established a command center, and multiple agencies are assisting as first responders search and assess the damage.
- Fire officials in Hobart, Indiana, said the city experienced significant impacts from the storm, including power outages, downed power lines, fallen trees, flooded roadways and road closures throughout the city.

Tropical Activity – Atlantic

Disturbance 1

- A broad area of low pressure is producing disorganized showers and thunderstorms.
- Located Southwestern Gulf of Mexico (Bay of Campeche).
- Currently moving slowly pushing northwestward.
- This system could re-emerge over the northwestern Gulf on Tuesday and Wednesday while interacting with a frontal boundary.
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (10%)
- Formation chance through 7 days: Low (10%)
