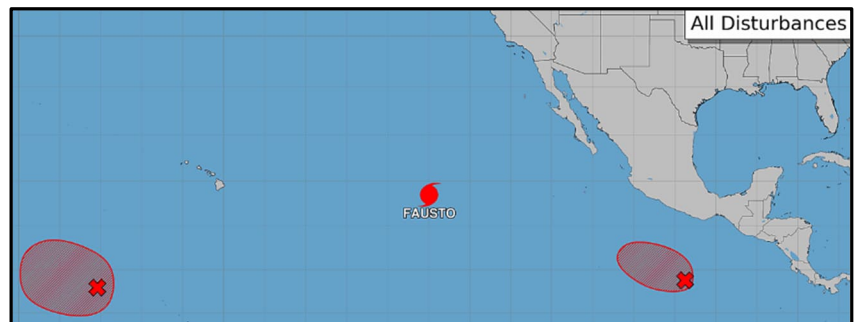

Tropical Storm Bertha

- Bertha has officially dissipated after moving inland across Texas, signaling the end of the system's brief tropical run as all coastal watches and warnings were lifted.
- Tropical Storm Bertha made landfall in St. Bernard Parish, Louisiana, on July 22, 2026, with maximum sustained winds of about 45 mph.
- Bertha gradually weakened as it lashed parts of the southwestern Louisiana and Upper Texas coasts with tropical-storm-force winds and coastal flooding.
- Storm surge of up to 2–3 feet inundated low-lying coastal roads and communities, particularly in southeastern Louisiana.
- Tropical-storm-force winds downed tree limbs, caused isolated power outages, and produced minor wind damage to signs and other unsecured objects.
- State officials and meteorologists reported that impacts were generally minor to moderate, with localized flooding and limited wind damage rather than extensive destruction.

Tropical Activity – Pacific Hurricane Fausto

- Located 1325 miles West of southern tip of Baja.
- Moving West at 15MPH.
- Maximum sustained winds have increased to near 100 mph with higher gusts.
- Little change in intensity is forecast through tonight, followed by steady weakening through the weekend.



Disturbance 1

- Located a several hundred miles south off the coast of southern Mexico.
- Conditions appear conducive additional development of this system, and a tropical depression or storm is likely to form later this morning.
- Moving west – northwestward at 10 to 15 MPH.
- Formation chance – 48-hour: High (100%); 7-day: High (100%)

Disturbance 2

- Located southwest of the Hawaiian Islands.
- Moving westward to west northwestward.
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (near 20%); 7-day: High (70%)

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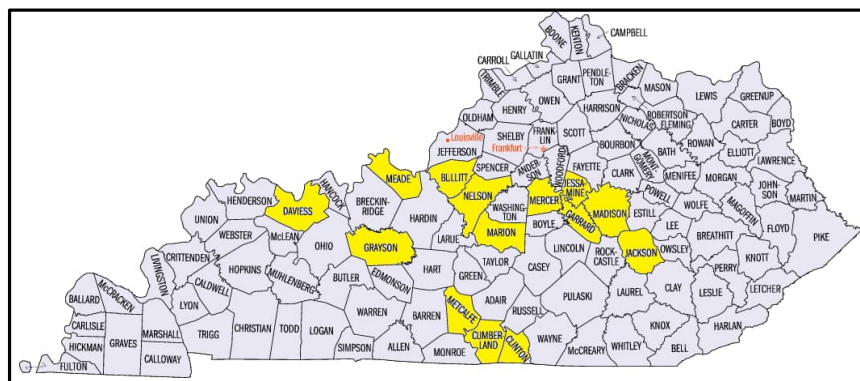
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Disaster Declaration Request Northern Mariana Islands

- Super Typhoon Bavi struck the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands (CNMI) as one of the strongest tropical cyclones of the year.
- The storm reached Category 5-equivalent intensity with sustained winds of approximately 180 mph and gusts exceeding 215 mph. The eye passed directly over Rota before moving westward across the Mariana Islands.
- Rota sustained the most severe damage after experiencing the eyewall and extreme winds.
- Saipan and Tinian experienced destructive hurricane-force winds, heavy rainfall, widespread power outages, and debris.
- On July 23, individual assistance was requested for 1 island.

Kentucky

- Between June 17 and June 30, 2026, Kentucky experienced multiple rounds of severe thunderstorms that culminated in a significant flash flood disaster.
- The period included damaging winds, tornadoes, torrential rainfall, and life-threatening flooding that resulted in fatalities and widespread damage.
- Floodwaters inundated hundreds of homes, with many sustaining significant water damage.
- Residents were evacuated from flood-prone communities as rapidly rising creeks and rivers entered neighborhoods.
- Numerous homes were left without electricity after trees and power lines were downed by severe winds and saturated soils.
- Some residences suffered roof damage, broken windows, and structural impacts from tornadoes and strong winds.
- Mudslides and washed-out roadways isolated neighborhoods and prevented residents from accessing homes.
- On July 23rd, Governor Beshear requested individual assistance for 14 counties.
